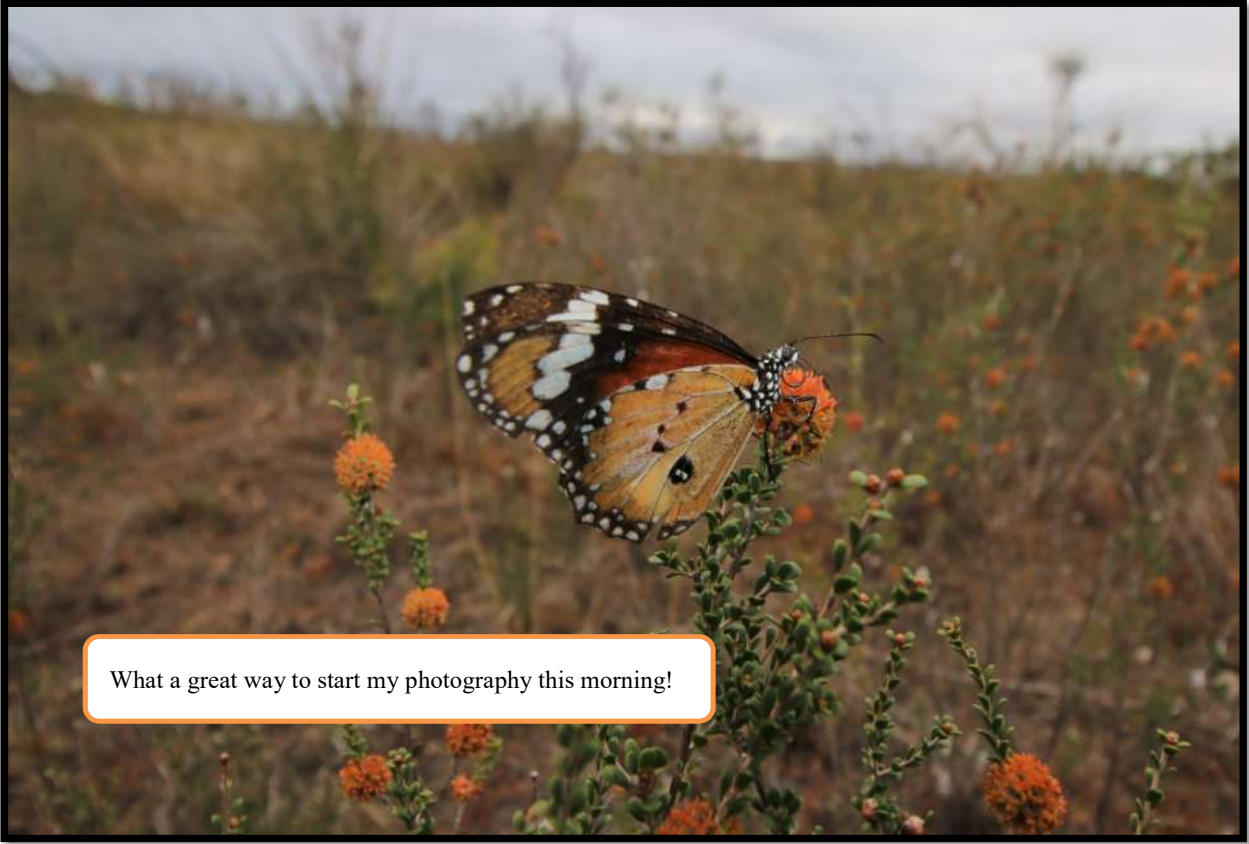

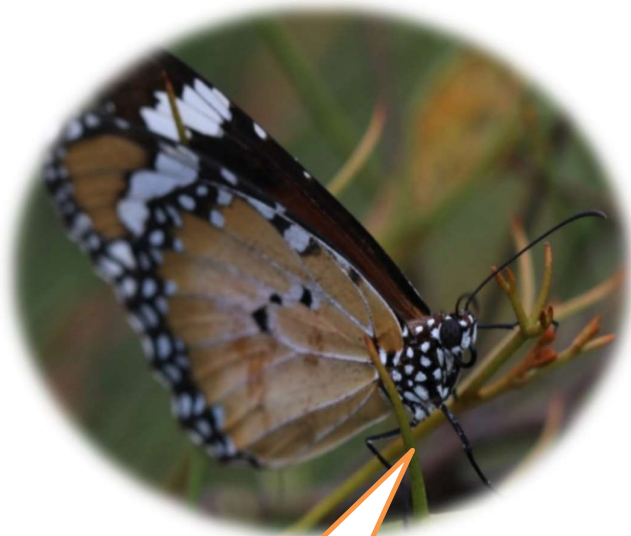
We are officially a very famous Friends Group now 😊!

This Dragonfly was taking cover in the rain!

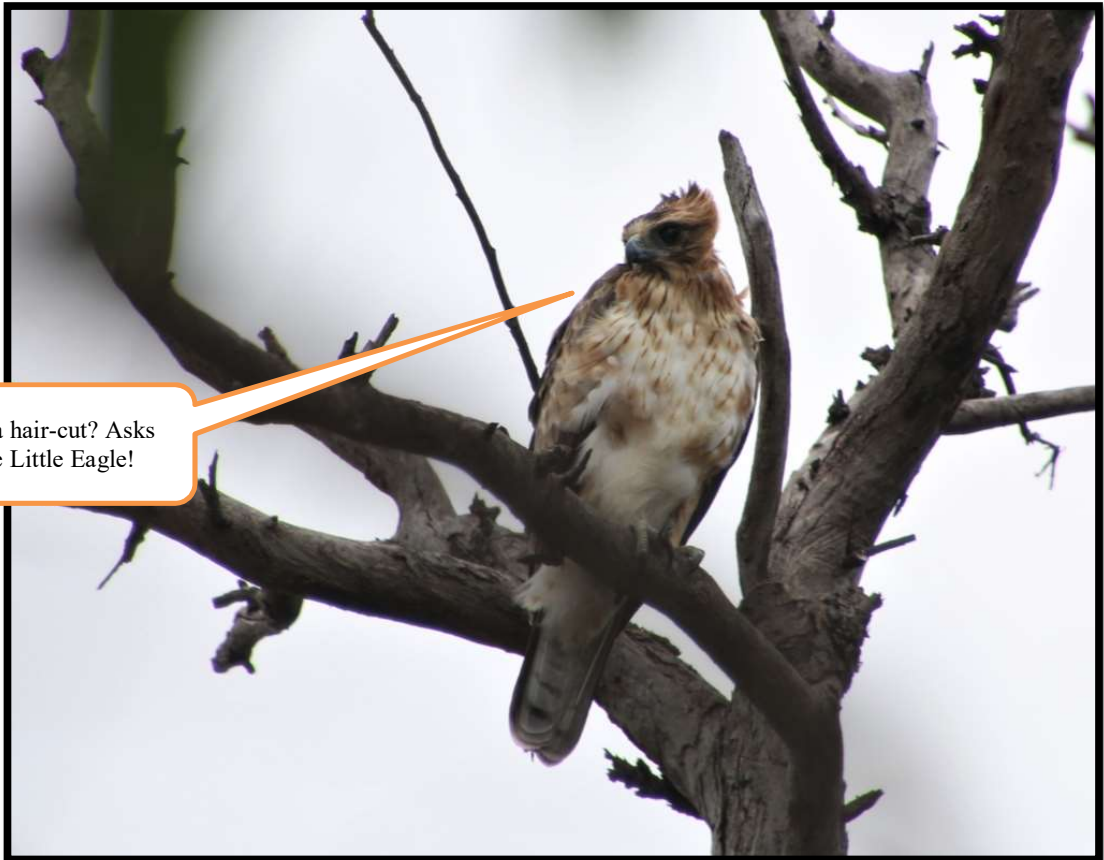


Geezzz.... this rain is making everything slippery, I'm struggling to balance here – says the perfectly camouflaged Katydid!
